VOICEMAIL

A call is answered by your voice mail when you do not answer your phone after a designated number of rings, or when you are on the phone and do not subscribe to call waiting. The caller hears your greeting and can then leave a message.

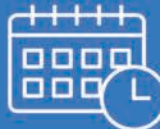
The message is stored in your mailbox until you listen to it. The mailbox holds 30 minutes of messages. You can then delete the message or keep it to play again later. New Messages are held for 30 days. Saved messages are saved for 7 days and then are deleted automatically unless they are re-saved as new.
